DAY 3: SAT MAY 2, 10 - 4.30


Limited to 8 participants

Day 1: A day of dreaming and inspiration! We'll cover garden design for wellbeing & how a personalised garden is created using a dream file. We'll do some dreaming, assess the good and bad of your garden and begin to discover the elements needed to uplift each person.

Day 2: A big day of possibilities.. Tackling the practical issues of the garden first, then onto solutions! The beginnings of the design will be guided onto paper and you'll head home with plenty to work on!

Day 3: A day to commit the dream to paper. With loads of expert guidance your design will come to life, creating the feeling and connection you need in your sanctuary. We'll look at building materials, how to get it done and the next steps.

NOTE: Plant grouping ideas and significant plants will be discussed throughout the course. We may not have time to create a detailed planting design in class but guidance happily given on any work done before the third day.
